- Create a personal website with testimonials, services, and case studies
- Grow your email list with lead magnets (e.g., "Free SEO Audit Checklist")

- Freelance Platforms: Up work, Fever, Freelancer, PeoplePerHour
- Job Boards: WeWorkRemotely, RemoteOK, Workana
- Cold Outreach: Email or LinkedIn DMs
- Referrals: Ask past clients and your network
- Local Clients: Reach out to small businesses near you

7. Pricing Your Services

- Research market rates in your niche
- Start with competitive pricing, raise with experience
- Always value your time and expertise
- Offer packages (e.g., SEO Audit + Strategy = ₹15,000)

8. Tools You'll Need

- Project Management: Trello, Notion, Asana
- Communication: Slack, Zoom, Google Meet
- Analytics: Google Analytics, Facebook Business Suite
- **Design**: Canva, Adobe Express
- **SEO**: Ubersuggest, Ahrefs, Google Search Console

- Use contracts (basic freelancing agreement)
- Set clear timelines and deliverables
- Communicate regularly
